## WE PRESENT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTIONS ON THIS THE 10TH OF JUNE 1774:

- 1<sup>ST</sup>. That the acts of Parliament of Great Britain in divesting us of the right to give and grant our money, and assuming such power to themselves, are unconstitutional, unjust and oppressive.
- 2<sup>ND</sup>. THAT IT IS AN INDISPENSABLE DUTY WE OWE TO OURSELVES AND POSTERITY TO OPPOSE WITH DECENCY AND FIRMNESS EVERY MEASURE TENDING TO DEPRIVE US OF OUR JUST RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES.
- 3<sup>RD</sup>. THAT A CLOSER UNION OF THE COLONIES, AND THEIR FAITHFUL ADHERING TO SUCH MEASURES AS A GENERAL CONGRESS SHALL JUDGE PROPER, AND THE MOST LIKELY MEANS TO PROCURE REDRESS OF AMERICAN GRIEVANCES AND SETTLE THE RIGHTS OF THE COLONIES ON A PERMANENT BASIS.
- 4<sup>TH</sup>. THAT WE WILL SINCERELY AND HEARTILY AGREE TO, AND ABIDE BY, THE MEASURES WHICH SHALL BE ADOPTED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL CONGRESS OF THE COLONIES.
- 5<sup>TH</sup>. THAT A COMMITTEE BE APPOINTED TO CONFER WITH SIMILAR COMMITTEES, RELATIVE TO THE PRESENT EXIGENCY OF AFFAIRS.
